Education Award Application Information

PURPOSE OF AWARD

The purpose of this Education Award is to assist to pay for a student's education expenses. Each Education Award will be at least \$1,000 and to a minimum of four (4) Native American Students will be awarded and made payable directly to the school.

Who is Eligible to apply:

1. Native American High School students invited to the Southern California Tribal Chairmen's Association 2016 High School Graduation Celebration.
2. Be recognized as a part-time/full-time candidate at an accredited institution of higher learning(university, college, community college, or trade/vocational school).
3. Overall Academic Grade Point Average (GPA) preference is a 3.0, however all are encouraged to apply.

Education Award Application Information

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

The application must be completed in its entirety

A completed application requires all documentation listed below (Items 1 – 6).

An incomplete application may be disqualified

A COMPLETED EDUCATION AWARD APPLICATION LIST:

1. Completed Education Award Application Form
2. If an enrolled member or a descendant from a SCTCA consortium reservation provide documentation of tribal enrollment/affiliation
3. Documentation as a candidate to an accredited institution of higher learning
4. Provide a high school transcript
5. One letter of recommendation of your community service & volunteerism from one of the following: teacher, advisor, coach, tribal government representative or civic leader
6. A one or two page (typed, double-spaced) "Education and Tribal Community Commitment Essay"
 - a) Describe your chosen field of study and how you will use higher education to better your life and your tribal community
 - b) Describe what positive actions you have done for your peers and elders in your tribal community

Please include the required six items in a single envelope

VALEDICTORIAN AND SALUTATORIAN SELECTION:

A Valedictorian and Salutarian will be selected from the Education Award Applicants

The student with the highest academic (GPA) rank is the determining factor in the selection of the Valedictorian.

The student with the second highest academic (GPA) rank is the determining factor in the selection of Salutarian.

THE VALEDICTORIAN AND SALUTATORIAN ARE REQUIRED:

To be present at the 2016 Southern California Tribal Chairmen's High School Graduation Celebration
Must appear at the podium to accept the award & are welcome to speak at the podium the evening of the High School Graduation Celebration.

Quotes from the Valedictorian and Salutarian Tribal Commitment Essay and a senior picture will be featured in the printed program
