Many Native children spend the holidays away from their parents, maybe with relatives and sometimes with a foster family away from their community. Since 2004, Tribal Family Services has ensured the children and families know their community cares with the Annual Foster Family "Angel Tree". This is where you can help and contribute to a local foster family this season.

Located at Tribal Family Services lobby in Building "B" the "Angel Tree" is up and ready in time for your "Black Friday" shopping!

If you are able to contribute this year, the process is easy as 1, 2, 3!

- 1. Pick an Ornament- the gender and age of the child is listed**
- 2. Shop for a gift**
- 3. Bring "unwrapped gift" back to Tribal Family Services by December 16th**

This year we have less foster youth in care but more "Angel Tree" ornaments- How can this be? We also provide gifts to ALL the CHILDREN in the household and try not to single out the child in foster care. This is done very tactfully and with a large degree of care by TFS staff. Come by and see how you may help or just come by to check out the Christmas lobby to say Hello.
