While these altars are the focus of the festival, the event will also feature live music by **Son de San Diego** and **Mariachi Divinas** and Ballet Folklórico by youth from **Tierra Caliente Academy of Arts**.

The Center's Museum exhibition, **Re-Membering Our Ancestors Discovering Ourselves**, will be **free and open to the public** for the duration of the Festival. Additionally, guests can enjoy free face painting, sugar skull decorating, and other celebratory activities. Traditional Mexican fare will also be available for purchase. Before the Festival, enjoy **México...Vive Su Folklor**, a special Ballet Folklórico performance by Tierra Caliente Academy of Arts.
