2020 Scholarship Program

Inter Tribal Sports, Inc., announces the 2020 **ITS Scholarship Awards Program**. Under the Program, a total of \$4,000 in scholarships will be awarded to Native American youth from the ITS service area in southern California. Graduating high school seniors or current college students attending a university, junior college, or trade school are eligible to apply.

Available Scholarships:

The number and dollar amount of scholarships is not preset and is dependent of the number and quality of applications received however most scholarships will range from \$500-\$2,000. The selection committee will allocate up to a total of \$4,000 in scholarships. Scholarships are available to graduating high school seniors, students attending a trade school, or current college students attending a community/junior college or four-year university/college in pursuit of a Bachelors, Masters, or Doctoral degree.

Eligibility Considerations & Priorities:

Applicants will be evaluated on the following criteria as demonstrated in their submitted application materials:

- A record of participation in Inter Tribal Sports leagues, programs, and events
- Volunteerism in the community in non-school sponsored community service activities
- Participation in extracurricular school activities
- Financial need
- Graduating high school seniors must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0. Current college students must have a minimum GPA of 2.50.
- Proof of admittance or enrollment in a two- (2) or four- (4) year college or trade school
- Commitment to provide at least one day of volunteer service to ITS after receipt of scholarship (ex. Championships)

Review & Payment Process

The applications will be reviewed, and recipients selected by a committee consisting of members of the Inter Tribal Sports Board of Directors. The scholarships will be awarded in May/June 2020. Scholarship funds will be paid in August or September and **will be paid directly to the school** and not to the student.

Application Process

Applications may be downloaded from the Inter Tribal Sports website at www.intertribalsports.org. Applications may be submitted by mail, fax, or email. **Applicants must submit a complete application, including application, resume, statement of financial need, essay, school transcript, and letters of recommendation by 5:00 pm on Wednesday, April 1, 2020.** Applicants may call the Inter Tribal Sports office at (951)719-3444 to confirm receipt of your application. The review committee reserves the right to request additional information.
