Native Scholarship for Higher Education

The San Manuel Band of Mission Indians is hosting a Southern California Tribal Chairmen's Association (SCTCA) scholarship for tribal high school graduates.

The Native Scholarship for Higher Education will aid qualified Native American students pursuing higher education goals. Up to ten (10) \$2,500 scholarships will be presented. Recipients will be able to add the San Manuel scholarship to their list of achievements announced at the SCTCA 2024 high school graduation ceremony.

APPLICANTS MUST:

- Be a Native American High School graduate invited to the Southern California Tribal Chairmen's Association 2024 High School Graduation Ceremony.
- Write a 250-word essay response to: **What are your future educational goals and how do you see using your education to help tribal communities?**
- Include a letter of recommendation from a teacher (*must be within the last four years*).
- Provide a certified copy of your high school transcript, verifying a 2.5 GPA or higher.



Application and required items must be postmarked by April 8, 2024, to the San Manuel Education Department. Mail them to:

Scholarship recipients must show acceptance to an accredited community college, university, or vocational training program. The San Manuel scholarship will be provided to the institution directly on behalf of the recipient.
