### Scholarships

Scholarships starting from **\$1,000 to \$2,000** will be awarded to High School seniors exhibiting an interest and ability in athletics, who have an unmet financial need. These scholarships are available to all native high school seniors graduating this year, and who will be attending and accredited university in the fall 2022. Any funds received will be paid directly to the University. All scholarships will be reviewed by Friday, April 29, 2022 and awards will be made on Thursday May 12, 2022 at the SCTCA High School graduation banquet.

### Applications

Typed or neatly printed applications must be received by **April 29, 2022**. All submitted applications must be accompanied by:

- 1) High school transcripts
- 2) Two letters of recommendation - one from a high school counselor, and one from a teacher, community leader or employer.
- 3) Letter of acceptance from an accredited university
- 4) Most recent high school picture (will be used for scholarship winners)

### Personal Statement

A one paged typewritten personal statement must be included with your application, stating the reasons you are applying for this scholarship. You may also include reasons why you decided to continue your education, your education or career goals, personal background and interests, etc.

### Grade Point Average

A minimum G.P.A. of 2.0 (on a 4.0 scale) is necessary to qualify
